Chair Hoang reported detection of a compromise of a system hosting a public facing website. A threat actor leveraged a vulnerable 3rd party software plugin as the initial attack vector and leveraged a kernel vulnerability as a secondary vector to compromise the server and website. Upon discovery of the compromise after hours, a managed service proactively took the site offline. The systems team responded to quickly restore an older version of the system, mitigated the known vulnerabilities, and proceeded to complete post-incident protocols.

Member Ito reported on a ransomware incident impacting one of their programs. The incident had taken many systems offline. Given the severity of the incident, cyber liability insurance was activated and a 3rd party incident response service leveraged for remediation efforts. Administrative and technical remedies being implemented included establishing an Information

Security Task Force, requiring that staff read and attest to security policies, deploying endpoint detection and response software across all departments, and either deleting or encrypting files containing social security numbers.

With no further discussion, Chair Hoang announced the end of the executive session.
